TRAINS

Normal train services to and from Newcastle train station will be running throughout the day as per normal schedules. Extra 'Special Event Train Services' will be running all day in addition to the standard train services. Ticket Costs

Tickets for train services will be FREE OF CHARGE to event ticket holders. The costs are integrated into the ticket price.

TAXI SERVICES

A taxi rank will be provided adjacent to Newcastle Station on Scott Street where private vehicles can drop off and pickup from before, during and after the event.

These will both be located toward the Watt Street intersection along Enterprise Park.

It will be serviced by Newcastle Taxis and managed by traffic controller /security to ensure pedestrian safety and orderly set down / pickups. Newcastle Taxis are aware of peak ingress and egress times for the event.

PUBLIC VEHICLES

There is a 'Public Set Down Area' adjacent to Newcastle Station on Scott Street where private vehicles can drop off and pickup from before, during and after the event. These will both be located toward the Watt Street intersection along Enterprise Park. Please note that these areas will be managed by traffic controlled and are not parking bays. Please follow the instructions of the traffic controllers and police. All Parent and private pickups are advised to be planned from this point.



CAR PARKING

There will be an event car park utilised for the event: **The Courthouse Car Park** Bolton Street, Newcastle
Capacity: 800 Cars. The Car Park will be FREE OF CHARGE.

LOCAL TRAFFIC, ROAD CLOSURES & ACCESS MANAGEMENT

Wharf Road from the Watt Street roundabout to the Nobbys Rd / Shortland Esplanade will be under controlled access points, where local traffic will not be granted access. Approved event vehicles will be granted access via presentation of approved event identification.

Taxi and set down areas are located within this region to remove vehicular congestion from immediate proximity of the event site precinct. The taxi and public set down area is within the area precinct surround the event site and Newcastle Train station. Only accredited event vehicles, event buses taxis will be permitted into the event precinct.
